# Challenges to attaining and maintaining representativeness on CRCs

- CRC resembling the community demographically (descriptive representation) is difficult to achieve in most communities.
- “The active population of any society is not representative of the population as a whole.” (Wollenbaek & Selle, 2003; Verba & Nie, 1972)
- CRCs are themselves small (< 12 members), and often pre-existing.
- Birds of a feather flock together (homophily).
- Burnout and turnover

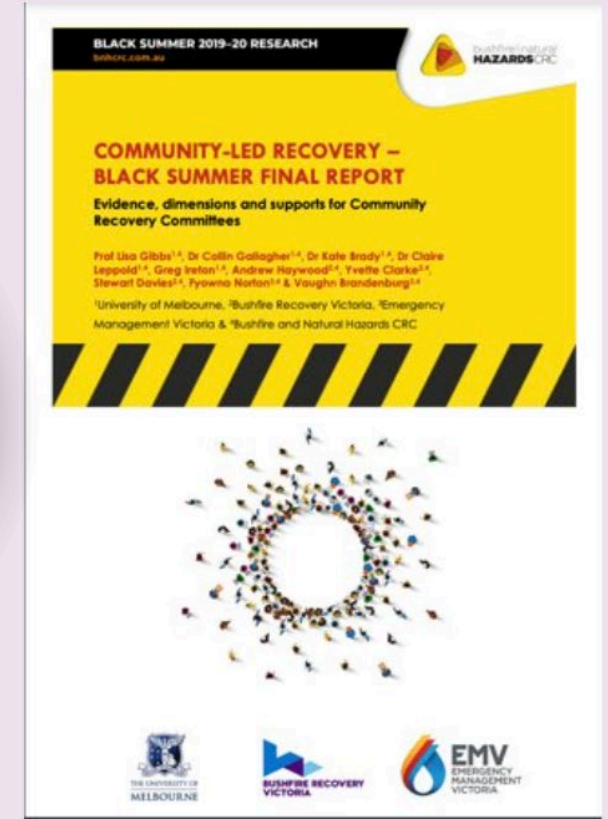

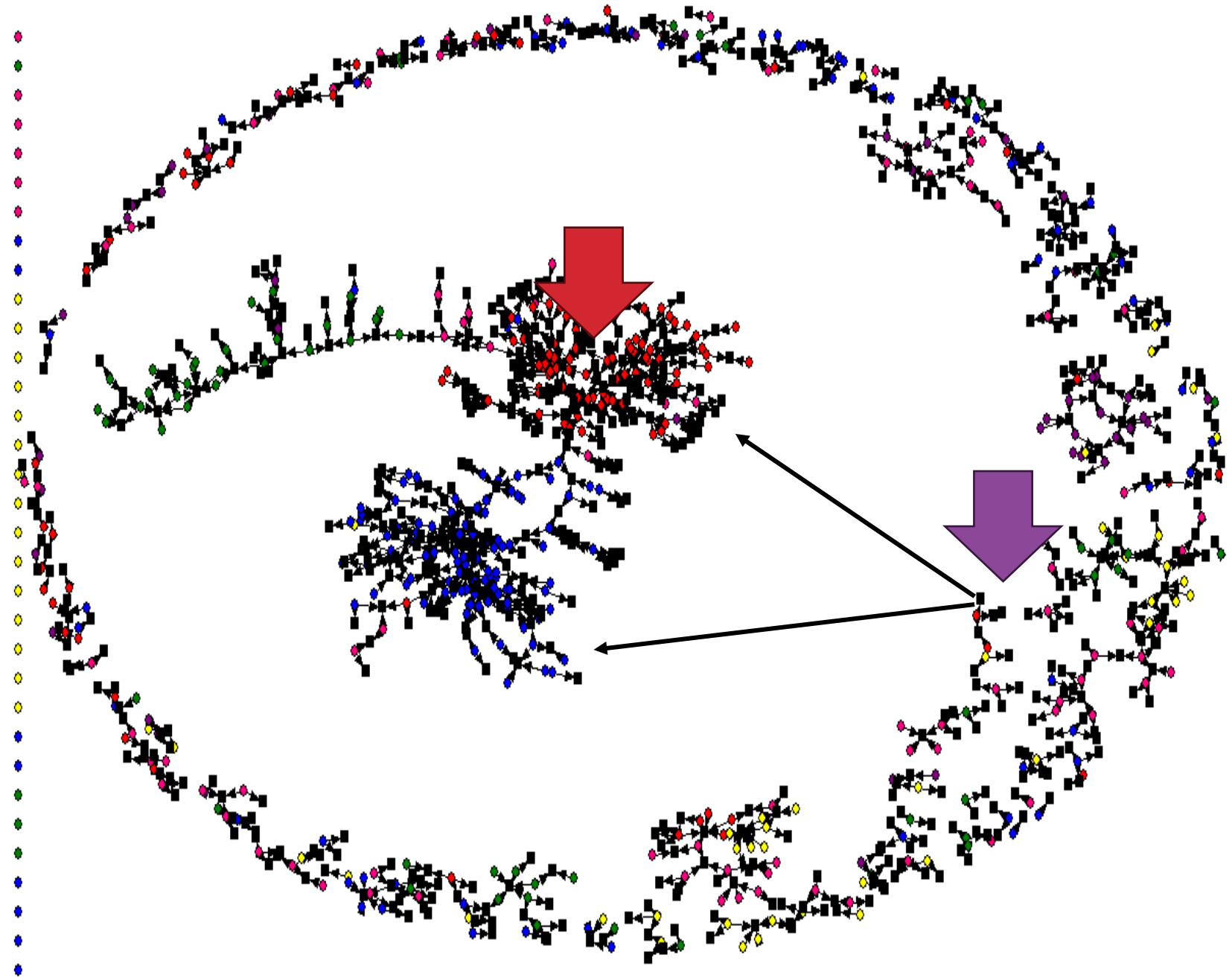

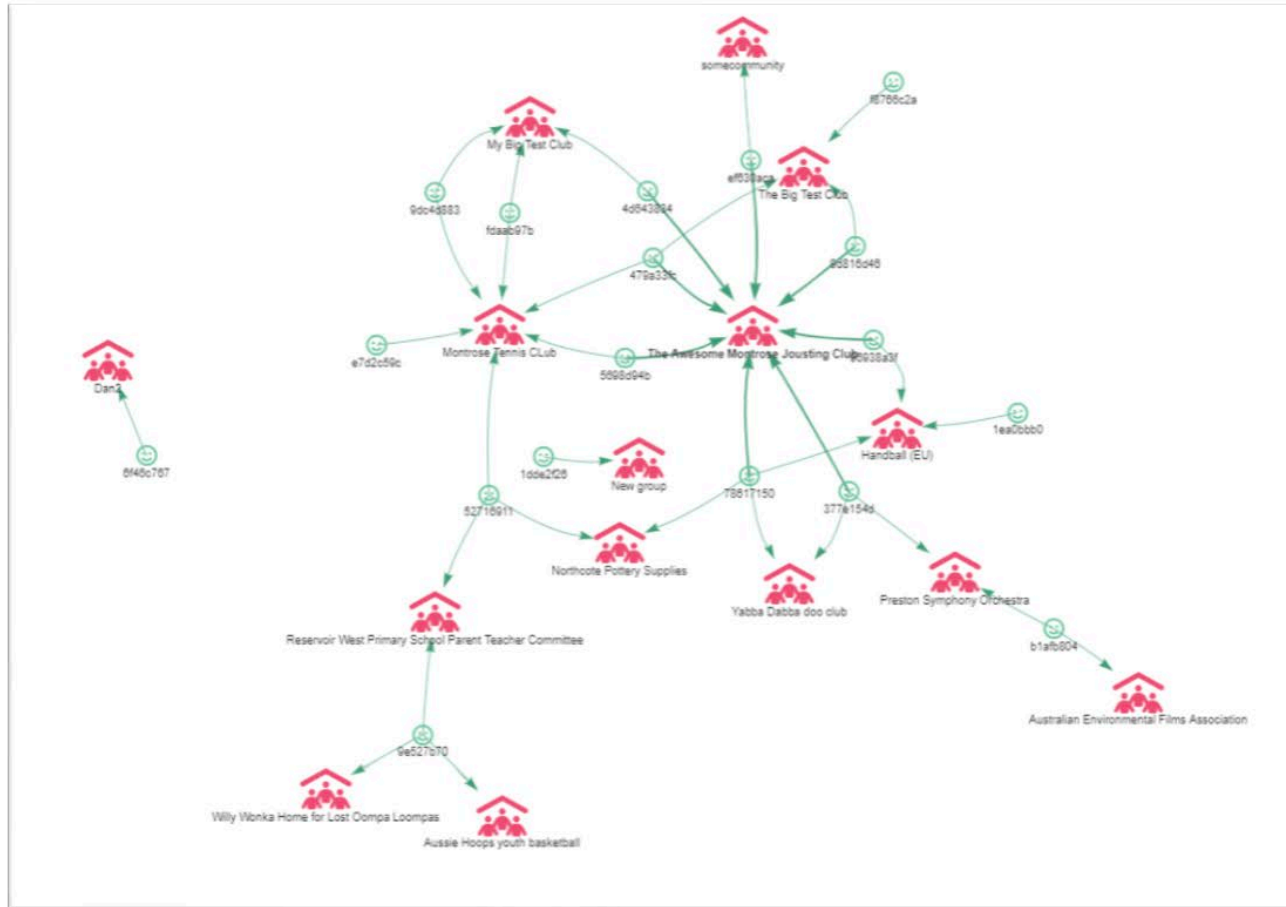


# How is the CRC connected to a diverse community?
