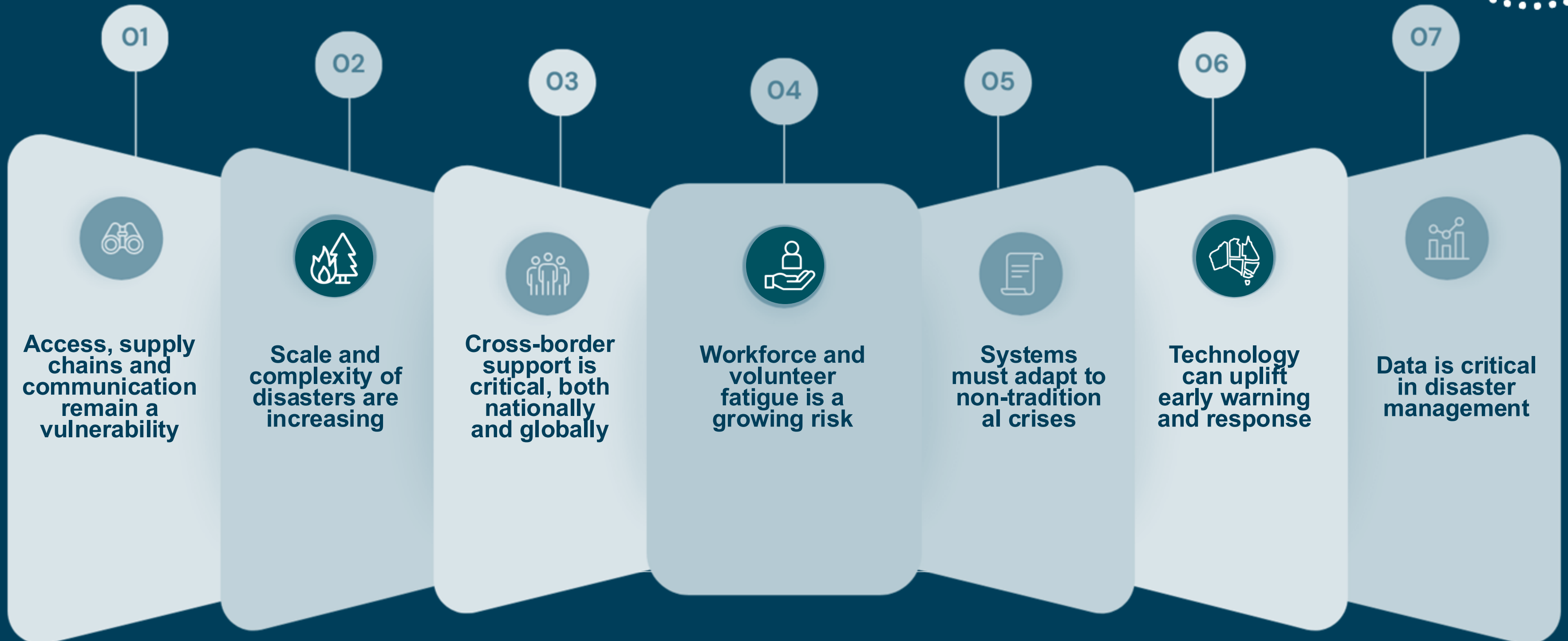
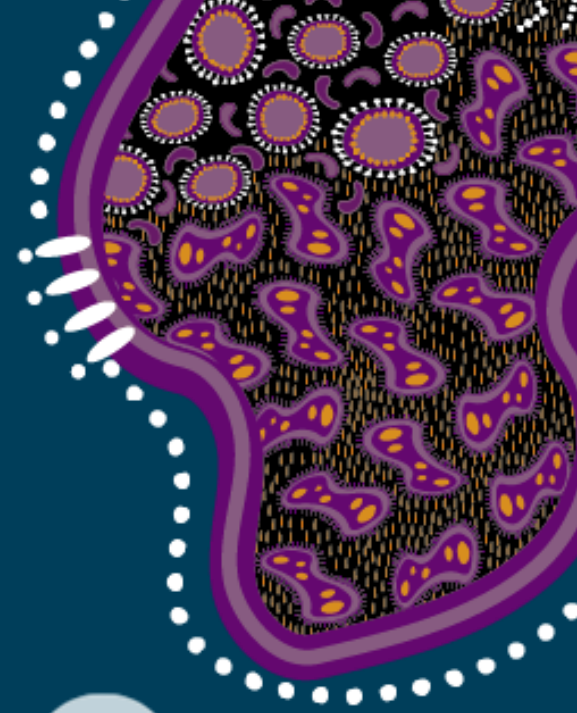


National Preparedness Program

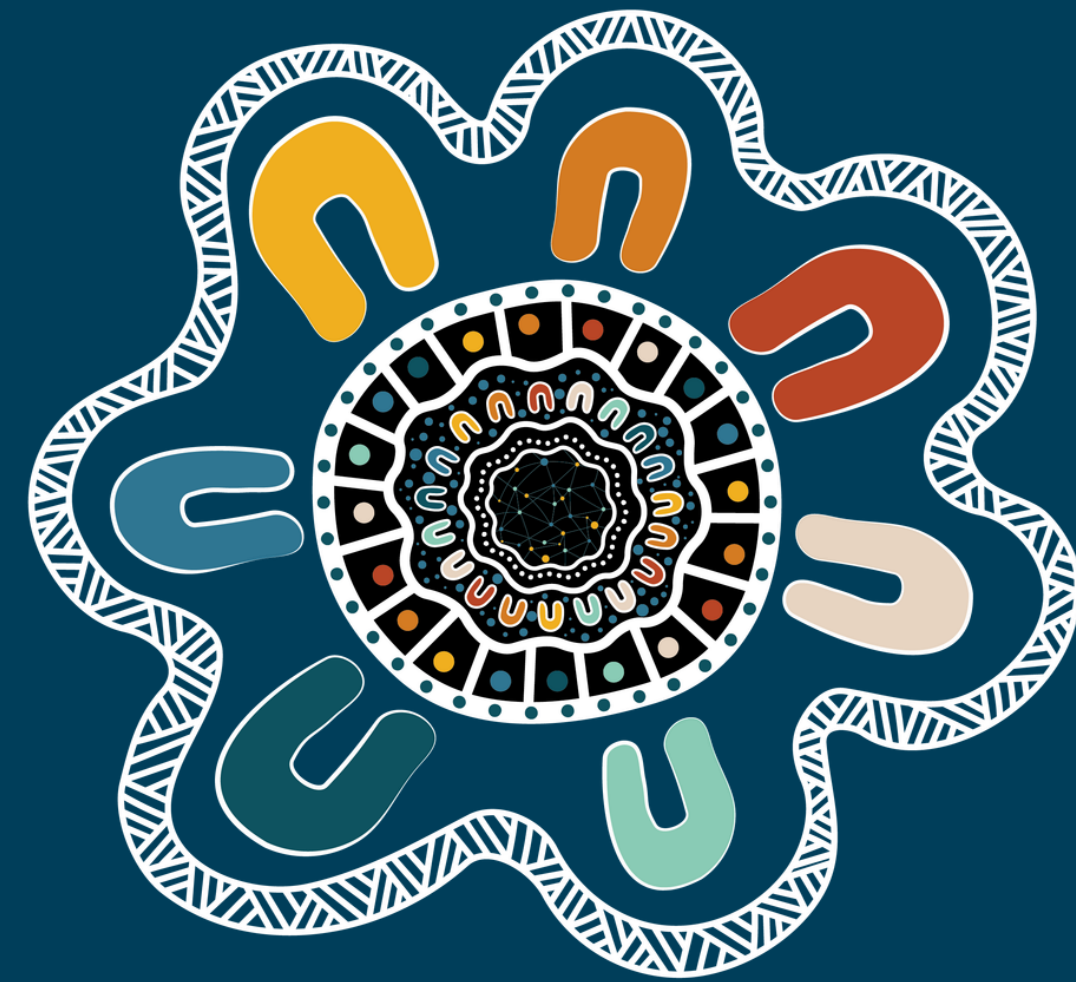
