# Help improve how we communicate weather information & warnings

## The Severe Weather and Heavy Rain Survey 2024



### What is the research about?

The Bureau of Meteorology, in partnership with Natural Hazards Research Australia, is conducting a study to gain insight into the Australian community's severe weather knowledge and experiences. The study will help researchers understand how people interpret and respond to information and warnings for severe weather. An online survey asks questions about participant's comprehension of warning messages, information preferences, perceptions and knowledge of flash flood, protective actions and experiences. Findings from the survey will be used to help inform future guidance and strategies for communicating risks to communities and assist emergency management prepare and respond to events to help keep communities safe.

### Who can take part?

Anyone! Participation is voluntary and anonymous. The survey is open to people in Australia aged 18 years or older. This includes Australian public and emergency management communities.
